Project Arizona's first major urban renewal project which targeted the most densely populated eighty acres in the state. Here amid small retail and service shops, restaurants, and entertainment venues, they openly lived and celebrated their culture. If American democracy, as Frederick Jackson Turner claimed, is born of free land, then its history may well be defined as the history of the fierce struggles to gain and maintain power over both the geographical, social, and political spaces of America and its concomitant narratives.
