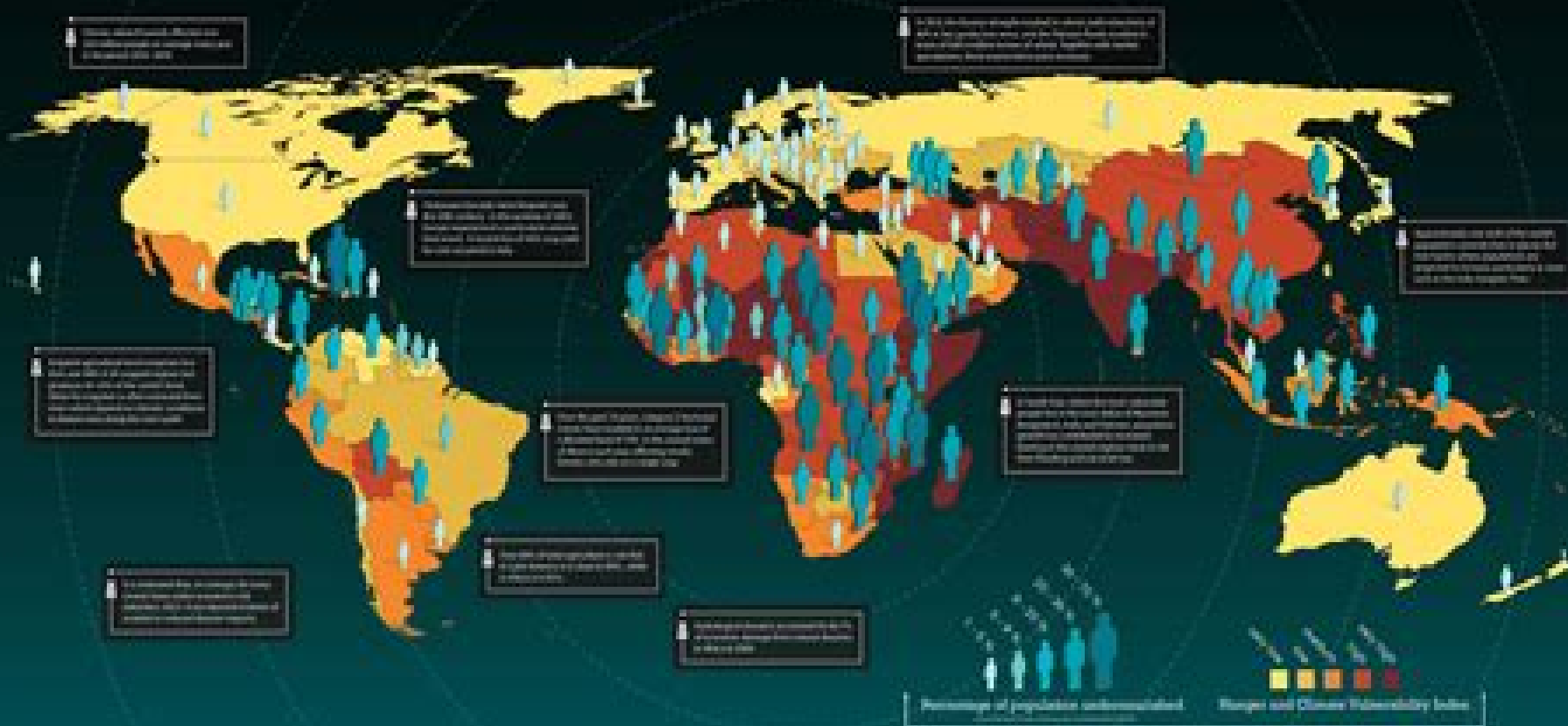


Food insecurity and climate change
