

establishes him as Pindar's rival Johnson shows the Horatian panegyrist is more than a dependent poet representing only the desires of his patrons. The poet forges the panegyric agenda setting out the character of the praise its mode lyric and content both positive and negative and calls together a community to join in the creation and adaptation of Roman identities and civic ideologies.
