black community He became a bank president and urged Planet readers to comport themselves as gentlemen but a year after he ran for governor in 1921 Mitchell's fortunes suffered a drastic reversal His bank failed and he was convicted of fraud and sentenced to three years in the state penitentiary The conviction was overturned on technicalities but the so called reforms that allowed state regulation of black businesses had done their worst and Mitchell died in poverty and some disgrace Basing her portrait on thorough primary research conducted over several decades Ann Field Alexander brings Mitchell to life in all his complexity and contradiction a combative resilient figure of protest and accommodation who epitomizes the African American experience in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries
