Second, it adopts two indigenous thoughts, Neo-Confucianism and geomancy, as sources of the main political and cultural ideologies that shape Korea's state and society relations. These sources have never been treated as units of political analysis. This book finds that both Neo-Confucianism and geomancy over two periods of Hanyang and Kyeongseong are two main contributing factors of the emergence of the developmental state and vibrant democracy in Korea in the Seoul era.


