From a Deflationary Point of View Paul Horwich, 2005-02-10 Deflationism has emerged as one of the most significant developments in contemporary philosophy. It is best known as a story about truth roughly that the traditional search for its underlying nature is misconceived since there can be no such thing. They concern a broad array of philosophical problems: the nature of truth, realism vs. anti-realism, the creation of meaning, epistemic rationality, the conceptual role of ought, probabilistic models of scientific reasoning, the autonomy of art, the passage of time, and the trajectory of Wittgenstein's philosophy. They appear as originally published except for the correction of obvious mistakes, the interpolation of clarifying material, and the inclusion of new footnotes to indicate Horwich's subsequent directions of thought.
