Halley was surely the 17th century's most active promoter of science serving for years as editor for publications of the influential Royal Society. He is acclaimed for encouraging the reluctant Isaac Newton to publish his ideas about motion and gravity. Altogether Halley gave the world much more than a name for a speedy comet. Yet the majority of these pass unnoticed by the general public. Most simply look like fuzzy stars with tails that are either faint or below the naked eye threshold.
