For the first time *The Next War in the Air* reconstructs the concept of the knock out blow as it was articulated in the public sphere, the reasons why it came to be so widely accepted by both experts and non experts and the way it shaped the responses of the British public to some of the great issues facing them in the 1930s from pacifism to fascism.
