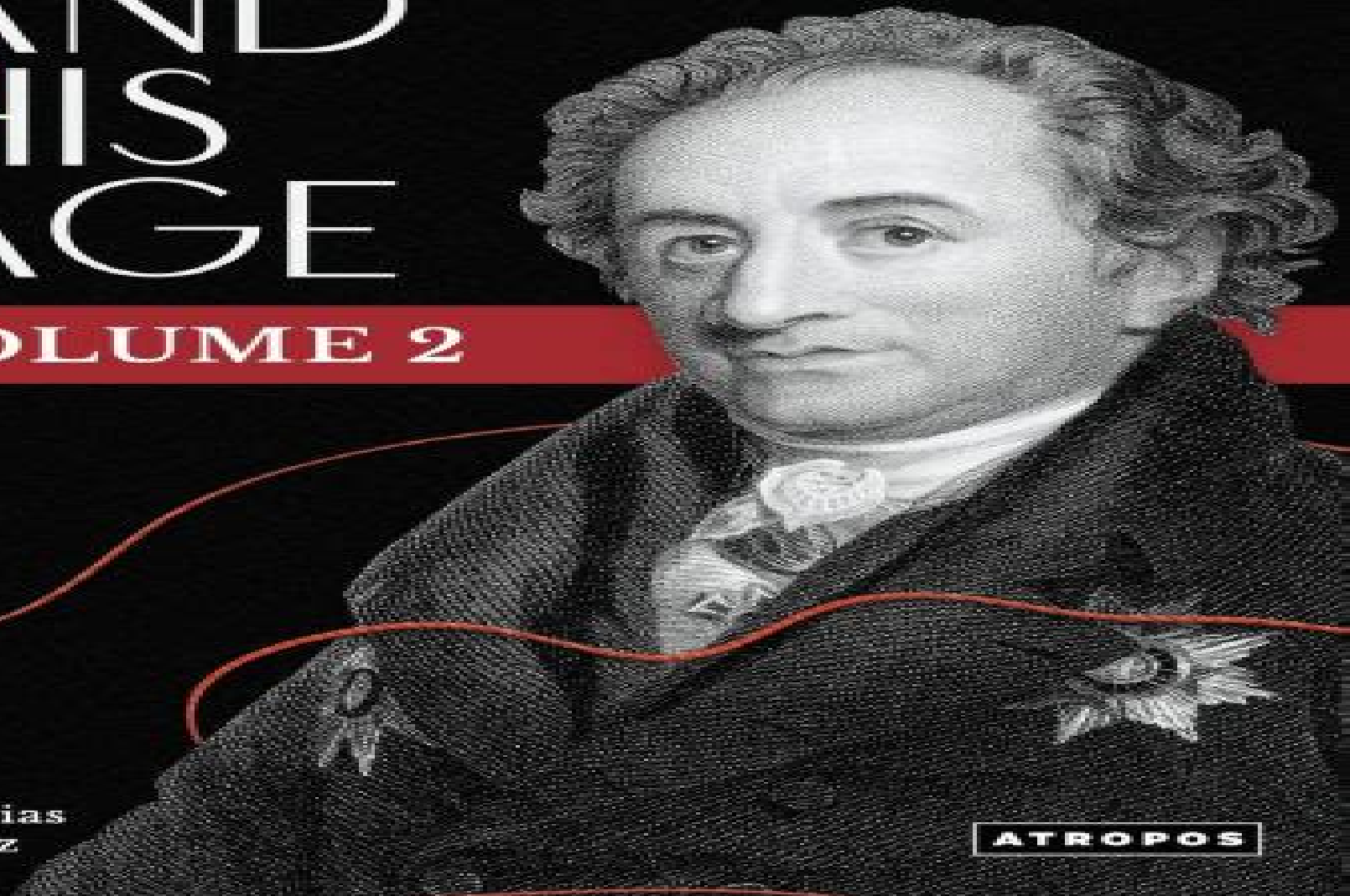

Goethe and His Age György Lukács, 1968 Description currently unavailable **Lukács Reads Goethe** Nicholas Vazsonyi, 1997 Long recognized as one of the foremost literary critics of the twentieth century the Hungarian born Georg Lukács 1885 1971 shocked many by turning to Marxism in 1918 Using his formidable knowledge of European cultural history he revitalized Marxist theory with his book *History and Class Consciousness* 1923 and continued to write extensively about literature The ultimate question posed by this book is how Lukács in the 1930s was able to write enthusiastically about Goethe citing him as an ideal exponent of humanism while simultaneously accepting and even condoning Stalinism
