Historical Dictionary of the Friends (Quakers) Margery Post Abbott, Mary Ellen Chijioke, Pink Dandelion, John William Oliver, 2011-12-01 The modern reputation of Friends in the United States and Europe is grounded in the relief work they have conducted in the presence and aftermath of war Friends also known as Quakers have coordinated the feeding and evacuation of children from war zones around the world They have helped displaced persons without regard to politics They have engaged in the relief of suffering in places as far flung as Ireland France Germany Ethiopia Egypt China and India Their work was acknowledged with the award of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1947 to the American Friends Service Committee AFSC and the Friends Service Council of Great Britain More often however Quakers live worship and work quietly without seeking public attention for themselves Now the Friends are a truly worldwide body and are recognized by their Christ centered message of integrity and simplicity as well as their nonviolent stance and affirmation of the belief that all people women as well as men may be called to the ministry The expanded second edition of the Historical Dictionary of the Friends Quakers relates the history of the Friends through a chronology an introductory essay an extensive bibliography and over 700 cross referenced dictionary entries on concepts significant figures places activities and periods This book is an excellent access point for scholars and students who will find the overviews and sources for further research provided by this book to be enormously helpful Liberal Quakerism in America in the Long Nineteenth Century, 1790-1920 Thomas D. Hamm, 2020-06-15 Thomas D Hamm Earlham College argues that a self conscious liberal Quakerism emerged in North America between 1790 and 1920 It had three characteristics The first was a commitment to liberty of conscience The second was pronounced doubts about orthodox beliefs such as the divinity of Christ Finally liberal Friends saw themselves as holding beliefs fully consistent with early Quakerism Stirrings appeared as early as the 1790s Hicksite Friends in the 1820s although perceiving themselves as traditionalists manifested all of these characteristics When other Hicksites took such stances in even more radical directions after 1830 however bitter divisions ensued Orthodox Friends were slower to develop liberal thought It emerged after 1870 as higher education became central to the Gurneyite branch of Orthodox Quakerism and as some Gurneyites responded to influences in the larger society and to the changes introduced by the advent of revivalism by embracing modernist Protestantism The Diary of Elizabeth Drinker Elaine Forman Crane, 2011-10-11 The journal of Philadelphia Quaker Elizabeth Sandwith Drinker 1735 1807 is perhaps the single most significant personal record of eighteenth century life in America from a woman's perspective Drinker wrote in her diary nearly continuously between 1758 and 1807 from two years before her marriage to the night before her last illness The extraordinary span and sustained quality of the journal make it a rewarding document for a multitude of historical purposes One of the most prolific early American diarists her journal runs to thirty six manuscript volumes Elizabeth Drinker saw English colonies evolve into the American nation while Drinker herself changed from a young unmarried woman into a wife mother and grandmother Her
