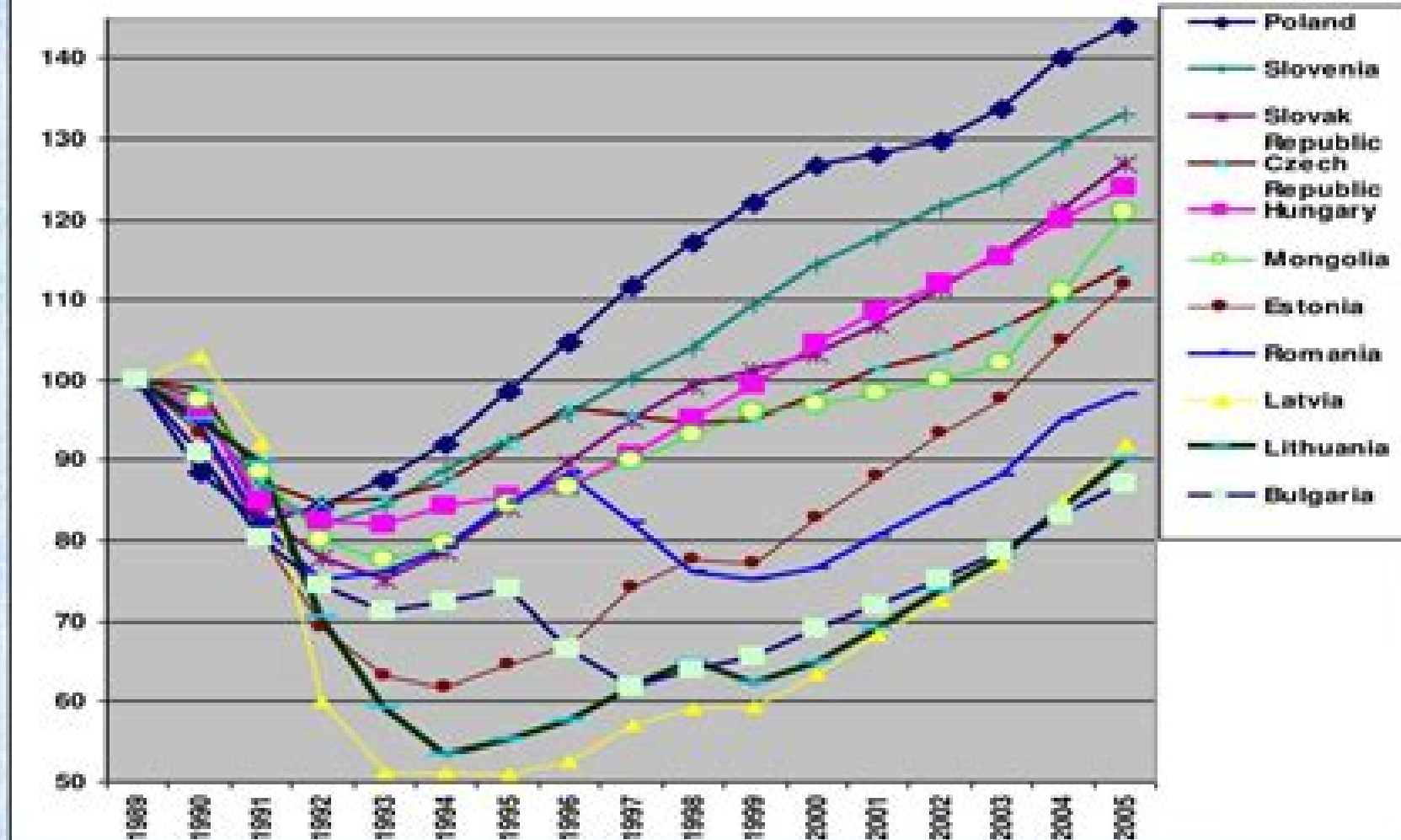


GDP change in EE economies and Mongolia, 1989 = 100%
