Union to Denmark after which she went to England and finally the USA As a result of the Hilter Stalin Pact of 1939 Houtermans was turned over to the Gestapo in May 1940 and imprisoned in Berlin The second part consists of two essays that narrate the life story of Yuri Golfand one of the codiscoverers of supersymmetry a major discovery in theoretical physics in the 20th century In 1973 just two years after the publication of his seminal paper he was fired from the Lebedev Physics Institute in Moscow Because of his Jewish origin he could find no job Under such circumstances he applied for an exit visa to Israel but his application was denied Yuri Golfand became a refusnik and joined the Human rights movement along with two other prominent physicists Andrei Sakharov and Yuri Orlov To earn his living he had to do manual work repeatedly being intimidated by KGB Only 18 years later shortly before the demise of the Soviet Union did he obtain permission to leave the country emigrating to Israel in 1990 These personal life stories of two outstanding theorists are interwined with the tragedies of the 20th century and make for compelling reading The Conceptual Completion and Extensions of Quantum Mechanics 1932-1941.
