

Induction of plant resistance



ISR (Induced. Systemic Resistance) is mediated by JA and ET signals that can induce different responses in the plants, for example, accumulation of ligner, callose, low molecular weight antimicrobial substances, synthesis of various proteins such as pathogenesis-related (PR) and other bacterial and tungal elicitors (Epopolysaccharides, isderophores, etc.)
