The inevitable consequence is that there will be an increase in the prevalence of older persons with chronic diseases multiple co existing pathologies and neuro degenerative diseases The oldest of the aging population are often excluded from drug trials and their treatments are largely based on findings extrapolated from that of the younger old Furthermore among the oldest old physiologically they are more diverse than other segments of the population Their demographic characteristics are unparalleled and different compared to that of the younger old Several studies have drawn attention to the differing attitudes among health professionals towards elderly people and many show prejudice because they are old As a result the use of age as a criteria in determining the appropriateness of treatment is of very limited validity yet there are limited resources that guide physicians through these
