family Although his life in physics has been sufficiently covered few have extensively studied his life and engagement in other fields He served military regimes and was closely associated with the birth of nuclear expertise in Pakistan where his membership of the schismatic Ahmadiyah community marginalised him His working life was divided between London s Imperial College and the International Centre for Theoretical Physics in Trieste Italy His fans perceive him as a victim of religious bigotry but on his part he did not seem to exercise scientific detachment in religion Abdus Salam had two wives His second wife Louise Johnson 1940 2012 was a leading Molecular Biologist who served as Professor Emeritus in Oxford University and it remains an awkward question as to how the two managed bigamy in Europe Abdus Salam validated the Judaic Muslim prohibition of pig meat and went as far as judging people who consumed pork as shameless like the beast itself A substantial amount of information provided in the book is supported by direct one to one interviews the author of the book conducted with Abdus Salam in 1984 Modern War and the Utility of Force Isabelle Duyvesteyn, Jan Angstrom, 2010-04-05 This book investigates the use and utility of military force in modern war After the Cold War Western armed forces have increasingly been called upon to intervene in internal conflicts in the former Third World These forces have been called upon to carry out missions that they traditionally have not been trained and equipped for in environments that they often have not been prepared for A number of these new types of operations in allegedly new wars stand out such as peace enforcement state building counter insurgency humanitarian aid and not the least counter terrorism The success rate of these missions has however been mixed providing fuel for an increasingly loud debate on the utility of force in modern war This edited volume poses as its central question what is in fact the utility of force Is force useful for anything other than a complete conventional defeat of a regular opponent who is confronted in the open field This book will be of much interest to students of strategic studies war and conflict studies counter insurgency security studies and IR Isabelle Duyvesteyn is an Associate Professor at the Department of History of International Relations Utrecht University in the Netherlands Jan Angstrom is a researcher at the Swedish National Defence College **The Powers of Speech** David Bathrick, 1995-01-01 In this definitive study David Bathrick examines East German culture both before and after the fall of the Berlin Wall in November 1989 Bathrick argues that dissident East German writers were unique among East European literary intellectuals in that they attempted to open up alternative spaces for public speech from within the framework of Marxism and state socialism According to Bathrick the fact that some of them had been censored hunted questioned and ridiculed does not belie the fact that they were also and sometimes even simultaneously privileged nurtured courted and coddled It was precisely their function on both sides of the power divide as official and nonofficial voices within the whole which defined a particular kind of intellectual in the GDR Bathrick applies his insights into this particular kind of intellectual to a wide range of topics He compares oppositional culture in East Germany to radical cultures elsewhere examines the complex political and cultural relations of East and West Germany traces the anguished history of the East German avant garde and describes the troubled
