Picasso's masterpiece he vividly conveys Picasso's transformation of all his materials into a wrenching cry against the suffering of war. Finally the work describes the odyssey of Picasso's canvas from its first display in the Spanish pavilion to its eventual arrival in Spain. Javier Tusell Gomez, the former director general of fine arts in Spain, contributes a chapter on the delicate negotiations that preceded the transfer of *Guernica* to Spain and the preparation at the Prado of a secure place to display the work.
