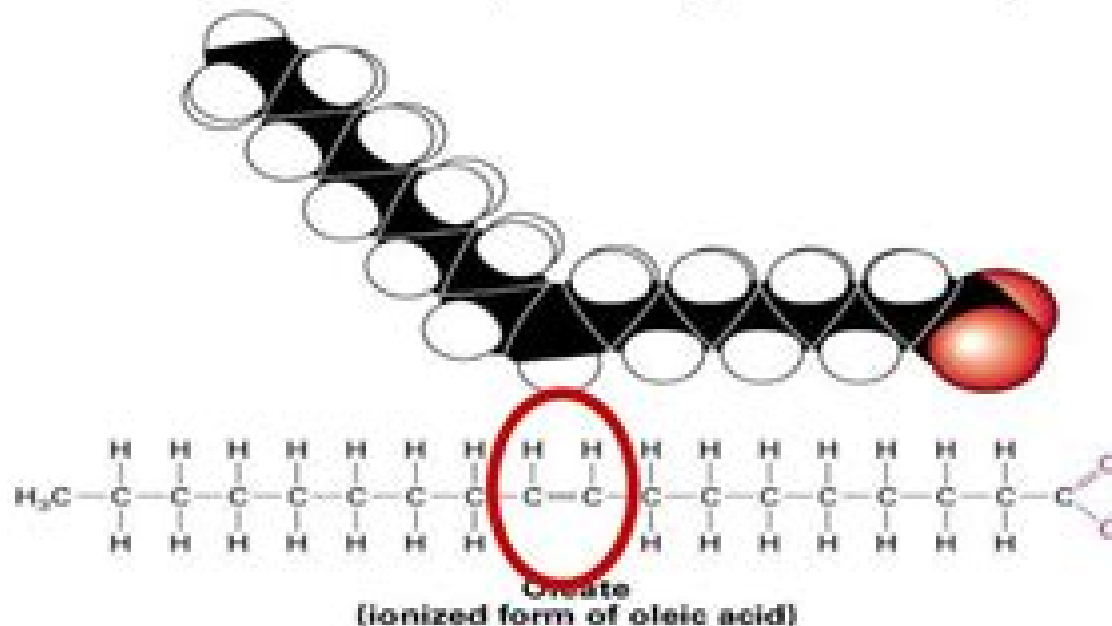


POSITIONAL AND GEOMETRIC ISOMERISM IN UNSATURATED FATTY ACIDS
