The Hakluyt Handbook provides a reference guide to the works of the Reverend Richard Hakluyt 1552-1616 and a critical evaluation of his achievements as a collector, editor, translator, and author of travel literature. In Volume I, part one consists of a series of essays by specialists in the various field with which Hakluyt was concerned and attempts to evaluate his significance for historians, geographers, and students of literature and society; part two comprises an analysis of the quality of his selections of material for his greatest collection, *The Principal Navigations of the English Nation*, in a series of regional studies; and part three is a chronology of his life and writings expanded from that in G. B. Parks, *Richard Hakluyt and the English Voyagers* 1928. Parts four and five in Volume II analyse the contents and sources of Hakluyt's three major works: *Divers Voyages* 1582, *Principall Navigations* 1589, and *Principal Navigations* 1598-1600, and provide detailed bibliographical material on the works with which Hakluyt was associated. A critical bibliography of secondary works and an analytical list of the publications of the Hakluyt Society 1846-1973 complete the work. An index of books and articles referred to in the volumes is included. The Hakluyt Handbook has been under consideration by the Hakluyt Society for more than a decade and owes much to the late R. A. Skelton 1906-70. The editor, Professor D. B. Quinn, has had the generous co-operation of more than twenty members of the Society in its compilation. It is hoped that the volumes will not only have value to members of the Society and to many students of the Elizabethan and Jacobean periods but that they will stimulate further research on Richard Hakluyt and a further refinement of our knowledge of Hakluyt's sources and bibliography. Studies of orientalism have chiefly concentrated on the eighteenth century and beyond while Renaissance work on colonial discourse and travel writing has concentrated on the New World. *Before Orientalism* examines early Anglo-Indian cultural relations through trade with the establishment of the East India Company, tourism, and diplomacy and illuminates important differences between the reports of travellers and the representations of the London press and stage. Richmond Barbour examines exotic visions of the East as staged in the playhouses at court and on the streets of Shakespeare's London. He follows the efforts of the newly established East India Company and the troubled, deeply theatrical careers of England's first tourist and first ambassador in India, Thomas Coryate, and Sir Thomas Roe. The wide range of illustrations depict early modern London's theatricalization of the world and exotic representations of the East and reveal European influences on Mughal art and the latter on English representations. **The Jacobean Grand Tour** Edward Chaney, Timothy Wilks, 2013-12-13. Although the eighteenth century is traditionally seen as the age of the Grand Tour, it was in fact the continental travel of Jacobean noblemen which really constituted the beginning of the Tour as an institutionalized phenomenon. James I's peace treaty with Spain in 1604 rendered travel to Catholic Europe

both safer and more respectable than it had been under the Tudors and opened up the continent to a new generation of aristocratic explorers enquirers and adventurers This book examines the political and cultural significance of the encounters that resulted focusing in particular on two of England's greatest and newly united families the Cecils and the Howards It also considers the ways in which Protestants and Catholics experienced the aesthetic and intellectual stimulus of European travel and how the cultural experiences of the travellers formed the essential ingredients in what became the Grand Tour
