Chase, President Abraham Lincoln, U.S. Senator Stephen Douglas, Andrew Johnson, whom Lincoln named his vice president in 1864, secessionists Jefferson Davis, Roger Taney, and Barnwell Rhett, John Breckenridge, the 1860 presidential nominee of the Southern Democratic Party, and Tennessee Senator John Bell. *The Men of Secession and Civil War* is a useful volume for Civil War courses.

Slavery, Race, and Conquest in the Tropics Robert E. May, 2013-10-07 *Slavery, Race and Conquest in the Tropics* challenges the way historians interpret the causes of the American Civil War.
