woman to hold this position Brown tells the stories of these doctors from the perspective of a black woman in medicine Her journey as a medical student already has parallels to those of black women who entered medicine generations before her What she uncovers about these women s struggles their need to work twice as hard and be twice as good and their ultimate success serves as instruction and inspiration for new generations considering a career in medicine or science
