This is not to deny the critical role in the group's success of professional songwriters including Ellie Greenwich and Jeff Barry and writer producer George Shadow Morton a pioneering and eccentric figure whose self mythologizing has generated a level of obfuscation that rivals that of the Shangri Las themselves MacKinney's clear sighted account reveals Morton in a completely new light and as part of a complex ecosystem of musical relationships Morton wrote and produced highly emotional material specifically for
