uniquely difficult position after the Civil War gives an unprecedented view of the era and of one solitary woman s attempt to negotiate its social and legal complexities in her struggle to find justice Baum s meticulously researched narrative will be of keen interest to legal scholars and to all those interested in the plight of freed slaves during this era
