McDermott, 1999 Most Americans believe that local school districts are the only means by which citizens may exercise control over public education Kathryn McDermott argues to the contrary that existing local institutions are no longer sufficient for achieving either equity or democratic governance Not only is local control inequitable it also fails to live up to its reputation for guaranteeing public participation and citizen influence Drawing upon democratic theory and the results of field research in New Haven Connecticut and three suburbs McDermott contends that our educational system can be made more democratic by centralizing control over funding while decentralizing most authority over schools to the level of schools themselves while enacting public school choice controlled for racial balance To many people in Connecticut and elsewhere the tension between equal opportunity for all students and local control of public education seems impossible to resolve In 1996 the Connecticut Supreme Court ruled in Sheff v O Neill that local control produces unconstitutional segregation of
