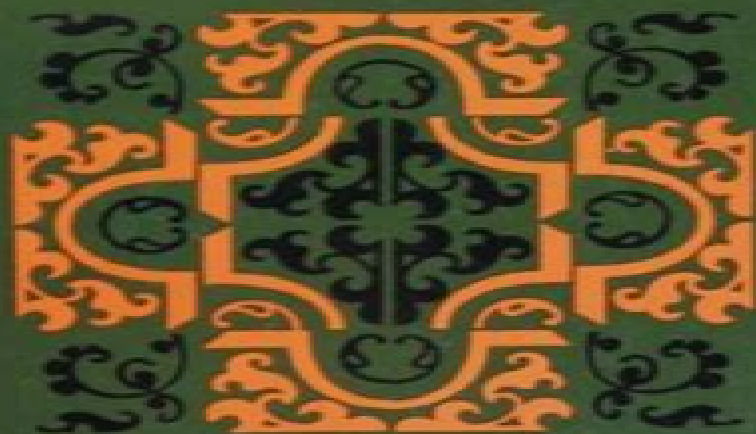

The strength of this work lies both in the originality of its project and in the precision and enterprise of the close reading that informs its argument. Arguing that Spenser's relationship to literary tradition is more complex than is often thought, Brown suggests that Spenser was a self-conscious innovator whose gradual move away from traditional poetics is exhibited by the different texts in the *Complaints*.
