Embodied Memory Anat Feinberg, 1999 In Embodied Memory Anat Feinberg offers the first English language study of the controversial dramatist George Tabori A Jewish Hungarian playwright and novelist Tabori is a unique figure in postwar German theatre one of the few theatre people since Bertolt Brecht to embody the ideal union of playwright director theatre manager and actor Revered as a theatre guru Tabori s career first in the United States and later in Germany is fraught with Jews and the Making of Modern German Theatre Jeanette R.
