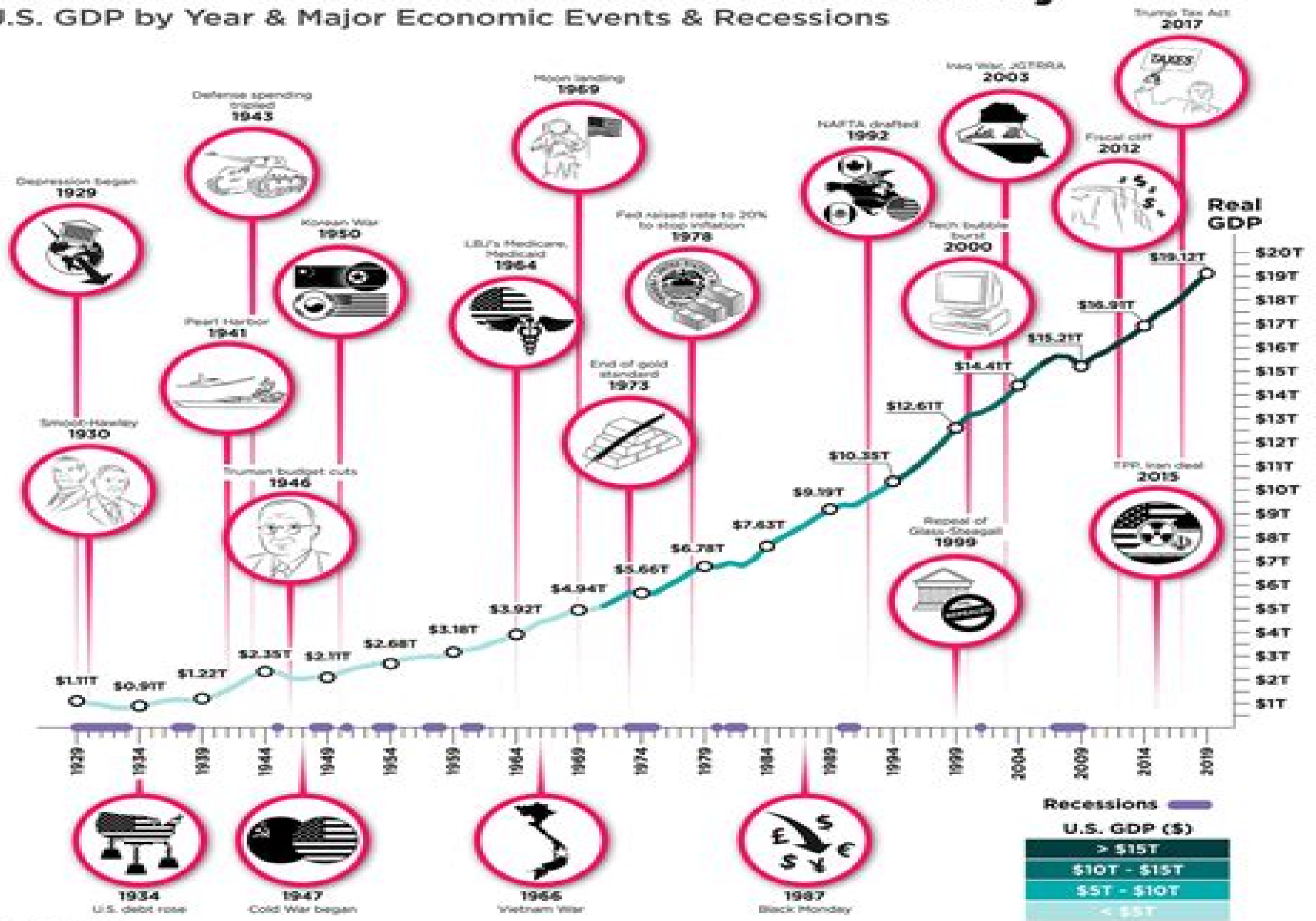


Timeline of the U.S. Economic History
