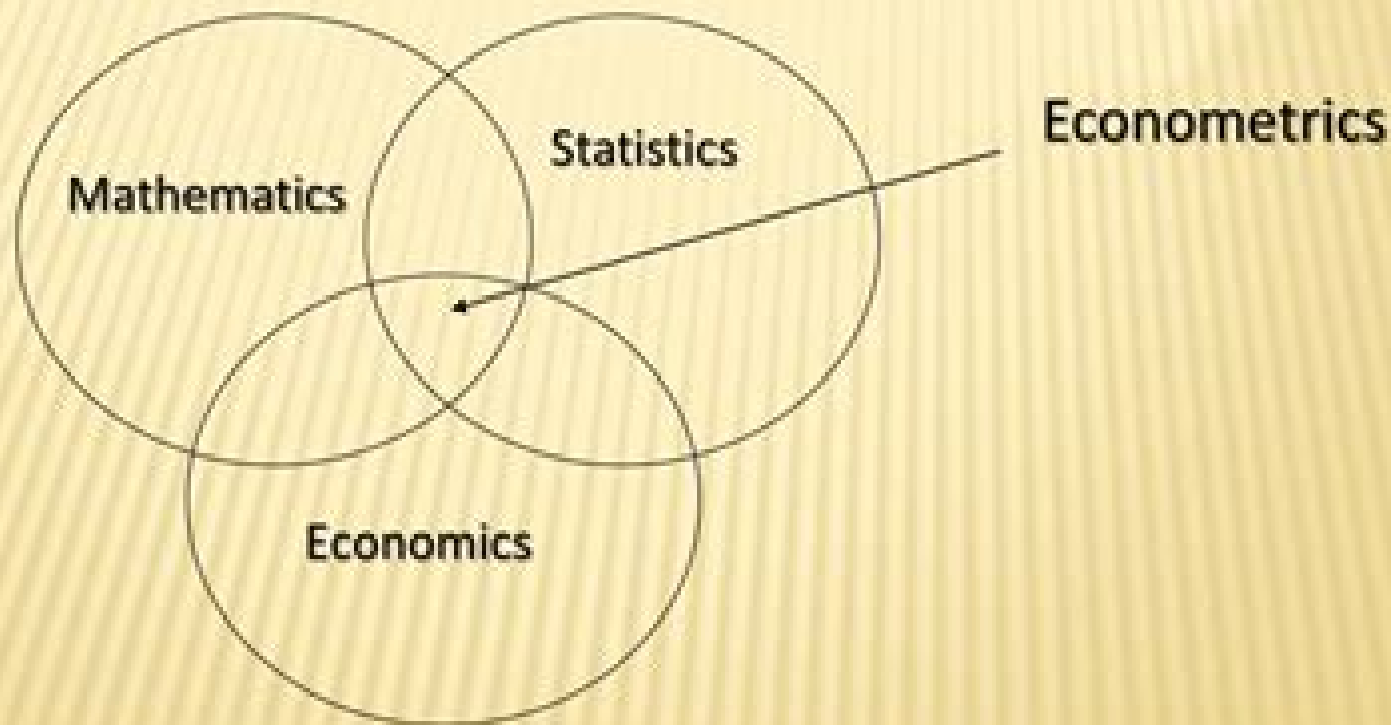

Luxemburg. His research career can be divided into two periods. The first one till 1981 was devoted entirely to pure mathematics. The other one after 1981 has been subdivided between pure mathematics and mathematical economics. The main objects of Roko's work in pure mathematics are spaces with order structure, Riesz spaces and operators acting on them.
