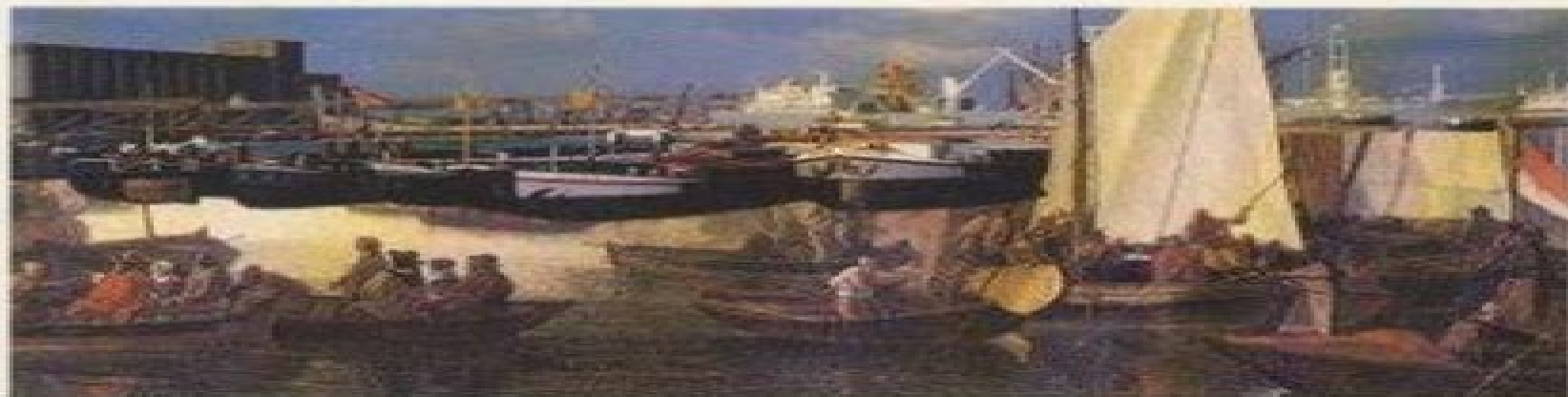

Een economische geschiedenis.** René De Preter, 2016-02-10 De achttiende eeuwse moraalfilosoof en verlichtingsdenker Adam Smith dacht dat het nastreven van eigenbelang in een vrije markt naar evenwicht werd geleid door een onzichtbare hand Later werd die markt veel meer gereguleerd en nam de rol van de overheid toe Tot een aantal economen en politici vonden dat de overheid moest terugtreden en plaatsmaken voor de krachten van de vrije markt Vanaf de jaren 1980 werd die liberale gedachte in de praktijk gebracht ook in België Tegelijk streefden Europese staten naar een eenheidsmarkt en werden handelsbelemmeringen op wereldschaal opgeheven De globalisering greep om zich heen Dit boek brengt deze evolutie in beeld en zoomt nader in op de gevolgen voor België Het is een economische geschiedenis die niet eerder werd gepubliceerd een ontdekkingstocht door het labirint van economische en maatschappelijke gebeurtenissen **Theorie van Bipolaire Wereld** HUANG FENGLIN, 2020-07-15 Dit academische werk dat de basisprincipes van het marxisme erft en ontwikkelt analyseert de historische structuur van de wereld met behulp van materialistische dialectiek en voorspelt de richting van de socialistische beweging en de manieren om het communisme te realiseren Het maakt niet alleen het horizontale dynamische deel van de marxistische theorie goed maar wijst ook op een logisch pad voor de ontwikkeling van de menselijke samenleving Bovendien voorspelt het het voorstel en de praktijk van China's The Belt and Road Initiative vanuit verschillende aspecten en biedt het de theoretische basis en reden voor het bouwen van een gemeenschap met een gedeelde toekomst voor de mensheid De theorie over de tegenstrijdige beweging tussen productiekrachten en productierelaties is het cruciale onderdeel van het marxisme en wordt gebruikt om socialistische revolutie en constructie te begeleiden en de wereldgeschiedenis te analyseren Klassieke schrijvers slaagden er echter niet in hun relaties te onthullen vanwege de historische beperkingen van de materialistische dialectiek en het gebrek aan horizontaal perspectief om de ontwikkeling van de natuur en de menselijke samenleving te onderzoeken Bijgevolg worden productiekrachten of productierelaties beschouwd als de enige beslissende factor in de marxistische theorie en praktijk en het argument blijft bestaan Dit boek gebaseerd op een groot aantal empirische analyses loste het fundamentele probleem van historisch materialisme op vanuit het perspectief van geografische concurrentie Dit boek houdt in dat na de uitvinding van de landbouw in het Neolithicum de concurrentie tussen soorten werd vervangen door geografische concurrentie op het land die de fundamentele motor is geworden voor de ontwikkeling van de menselijke samenleving Het zorgde niet alleen voor particulier eigendom en sociale organisaties zoals patriarchale clans

stammen nationaliteiten klassen landen en regio's maar zorgde er ook voor dat de twee polen van het oosten en het westen concurreren in veranderende sociale vormen productiekrachten en vormen ontwikkelen wereldgeschiedenis na de vorming van de Binnen Aziatische nomaden Dit boek verdeelt de geschiedenis van de bipolaire wedstrijden tussen het Oosten en het Westen na 500 voor Christus in drie fasen Het begin van de eerste fase werd gekenmerkt door het krachtige feodalistische China als de machtskern eindigend met de opkomst van het kapitalistische Verenigd Koninkrijk dat de machtskern was van de tweede fase Tijdens deze fase met de verwerving van grondbelastingen als drijvende kracht werden vier relatief onafhankelijke politiek economische entiteiten gevormd van oost naar west met afnemende beschavingsgraad het oude China Binnen Azië de islam en Europa aangeduid als Zone 4 Zone 3 Zone 2 en Zone 1 respectievelijk in dit boek De tweede fase met het kapitalistische VK als de machtskern eindigde met de ontwikkeling van het socialistische China dat in de derde fase de kern van de macht was De drijvende kracht in dit stadium was het bereiken van een grondstofmarkt Gebaseerd op het bipolaire wereldpatroon van de eerste generatie zijn twee relatief onafhankelijke politiek economische entiteiten het kapitalistische systeem en het socialistische systeem gevormd van het westen naar het oosten Deze fase was verdeeld in drie fasen van economische kolonisatie gericht op het rijk van publieke goederen natuurlijk monopolie en concurrentie Dit boek gebruikt een grote hoeveelheid historische gegevens om de specifieke niveaus van de twee fasen te analyseren Ondanks het feit dat feitelijke gegevensondersteuning soms niet voldoende is en sommige conclusies ter discussie staan is het theoretische systeem volledig in overeenstemming met macro gebeurtenissen en is het algemene kader overtuigend Door de eerste en tweede fase te analyseren maakt dit boek een theoretische voorspelling over de fasen en resultaten van de derde fase Dit boek houdt in dat de derde fase begon met de ontwikkeling van het socialistische China en zal eindigen met de realisatie van het wereldcommunisme en het uitsterven van geo competitieve relaties De drijvende kracht in deze fase is de verwerving van samenwerking op het gebied van eigendomsrechten Gebaseerd op het bipolaire wereldpatroon van de tweede fase zal het drie fasen ondergaan van samenwerking tussen staatsbedrijven op het gebied van concurrentie natuurlijk monopolie en publieke goederen De wereld van oost naar west zal een entiteit vormen zonder sociaal verschil De auteur is van mening dat tegen de achtergrond van het voordelige Westen en het nadelige Oosten in de economische globalisering een structurele unie op basis van geo economie de enige optie is Grensoverschrijdende samenwerking van staatsbedrijven is de enige manier om de natuurlijke beperking van de particuliere economie te doorbreken de belangrijkste status in de wereldconcurrentie te winnen het probleem van voldoende vraag in binnen en buitenland op te lossen de economische en politieke situatie van de arbeidersklasse in verschillende landen en zich te ontdoen van de afhankelijkheid van het kapitalistische koloniale systeem De eigendomsrechtelijke samenwerking van staatsbedrijven is daarom de fundamentele motor voor de toekomstige ontwikkeling van de menselijke samenleving Dit boek vat dit historische proces van economische samenwerking samen als n drijvende kracht de transnationale samenwerking tussen eigendomsrechten van staatsbedrijven

Industrial Retardation in the Netherlands 1830-1850 Richard Griffiths, 2013-03-09 Much modern Le post 1750 economic history is concerned with success in that a vast body of literature focuses its attention upon the experience of industrialisation and economic growth or upon relative differences in performance once the growth process is underway. The explanations advanced frequently hinge on those supply and demand factors perceptible during the growth period itself which may have helped or hindered economic progress. The problem which arises with this approach is whether those forces attributed with having pulled a country forward were the same as those which in their absence had held it back. For example, the growth of international demand may be seen as a major stimulus in the economic development of a particular country, but its effectiveness as a stimulant may have been contingent upon the prior removal of quite different obstacles to growth. In these circumstances it would be quite wrong to attribute lack of earlier development to the absence of international demand. Thus the study of a period preceding discernible growth in a sector of the economy may tell historians as much about the reasons for subsequent growth as a study of the growth period itself. This was my initial reason for choosing to research into the industrial development in the Netherlands in the first half of the nineteenth century, that it was an interval in economic history usually interpreted as one of stagnation of missed opportunities and even of economic decline.
