

- After 10 to 20 ECT shocks in alternate days, the improvement in most of the patients were startling.
- Significant improvements in the technique of ECT have been made since then, including the use of muscle relaxants, such as succinylcholine, the anesthesia of patients with short-acting agents, pre-oxygenation of the brain, the use of EEG seizure monitoring and better devices and shock waveforms.
