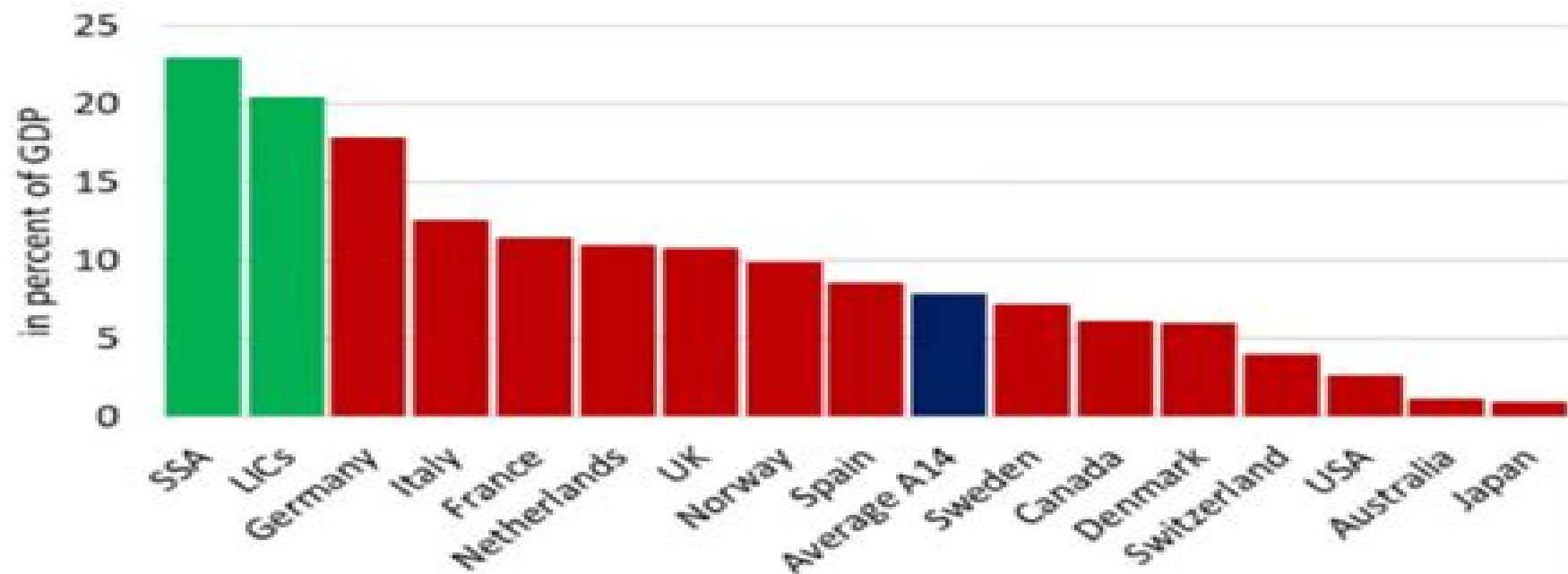


**Figure 1. Governments of today's low-income countries spent more on average in 2018 than today's advanced economies did in 1900 (in percent of GDP)**
