prisoners lived in Her kindness helped her gain the friendship of the prisoners and they began to try to improve their conditions for themselves Thomas Fowell Buxton Fry s brother in law was elected to Parliament for Weymouth and began to promote her work among his fellow MPs In 1818 Fry gave evidence to a House of Commons committee on the conditions prevalent in British prisons becoming the first woman to present evidence in Parliament Laura Elizabeth Howe Richards February 27 1850 January 14 1943 was an American writer She wrote more than 90 books including biographies poetry and several for children One well known children s poem is her literary nonsense verse Elelelephony which is adapted into an animated segment Vowel Letter Poem E Elephant produced by Jeff Hale and his animation studio Imagination Inc for the television show Sesame Street
