Kramers Between Tradition and Revolution Max Dresden, 2012-12-06 It is now a little more than 11 years since the idea of writing a personal and scientific biography of H A Kramers took hold of me A few days earlier I had been lecturing in a course on field theory on the renormalization proce dures of relativistic quantum field theory Since the students had considerable trouble understanding the physical basis of the procedure at the end of the lecture T explained that renormalization is not an exclusive quantum or relativistic procedure A careful treatment of classical electron theory as started by Lorentz and developed in detail by Kramers also requires re normalization.
