Mary Magdalene and Her Sister Martha Jane Cartwright, 2013
 Mary Magdalene and Her Sister Martha: An Edition and Translation of the Medieval Welsh Lives provides scholarly editions and English translations of the medieval Welsh versions of the legends of Mary Magdalene and Martha. Described by Victor Saxer as medieval best sellers, these hagiographical tales which described how Mary Magdalene and her sister Martha survived a perilous sea voyage from the Holy Land and evangelized Provence were available in many different Latin and vernacular versions and circulated widely in the medieval West. The texts were translated or adapted into Middle Welsh some time before the mid-fourteenth century; the Middle Welsh Life of Mary Magdalene is extant in thirteen manuscripts and the Middle Welsh Life of Martha is preserved in eight of the same manuscripts. Jane Cartwright makes the Middle Welsh versions available to an international audience for the first time and provides a detailed study of the Welsh manuscripts that contain the texts, a comparison between the different manuscripts versions and a discussion of the wider hagiographical context of the texts in Wales. The volume includes transcriptions, editions and translations of the two Lives based on the oldest most complete extant versions found in the Red Book of Talgarth c. 1400 as well as an additional section of text describing Mary Magdalene's life before Christ's crucifixion from the fifteenth century Aberystwyth National Library of Wales Peniarth MS 27ii. The edition is accompanied by a comprehensive glossary which provides translations of all medieval Welsh words that occur in the texts, an analysis of the development and transmission of the legends as well as a discussion of the relevance and popularity of these two female saints in late medieval Wales. Medieval Welsh poetry, church dedications and holy wells are also considered.

Women and Gender in Early Modern Wales Michael Roberts, Simone Clarke, 2000 Traditionally the narratives of Welsh history have been masculine in their emphasis *Women and Gender in Early Modern Wales* helps to redress the balance as it examines the material social and cultural experiences of women in Wales and explores how those experiences were defined alongside or against those of men It is the first book devoted to the lives of women in Wales during the period from the alter middle ages to the eve of the industrial revolution and the first study to deal with the history of shifting gender identities in Wales in any period Michael Roberts and Simone Clarke have brought together an exciting team of authors to examine the character and evolution of male and female identities in the early modern period Issues addressed include female contributions to the poetic tradition attitudes towards witchcraft and female abduction the role of women in the emerging Nonconformist movements the changing political and social responsibilities of men following the Acts of Union and an exploration of women s experiences as presented in a range of sources from the records of the law courts to the work of the embroiderer *Women and Gender in Early Modern Wales* is a pioneering yet accessible volume which not only has wide ranging and important implications for early modern Welsh historiography but also provides the basis for the comparative study of gendered experience in this period both in the British Isles and beyond

The Mary of the Celts Andrew Breeze, 2008 *The Mary of the Celts* is essential reading for anyone interested in the reality of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary in Celtic spirituality The book explores themes and images associated with the Annunciation Nativity Crucifixion and Assumption as also the Blessed Virgin s Joys and Sorrows through a detailed study of poetry on Mary from the Celtic regions of medieval Britain and Ireland There are haunting images such as the Blessed Virgin Mary as daughter of her Son and as the chamber of the Trinity with her virginity remaining as unstained and pure as glass pierced by a beam of light as well as references to popular apocryphal legends including those of the Instantaneous Harvest that grew while Mary and her child were fleeing into Egypt from Herod s men and of the girdle thrown down by the Virgin to St Thomas at the Assumption Indeed *The Mary of the Celts* has been written as a guide to Marian iconography It will be useful for students of medieval European literature and art as well as for specialists in early Irish and Welsh all of whom will find in it much that is new It should make readers aware of the wealth of Marian material to be found in Celtic Ireland and Britain not all of which has had the attention it deserves beyond the Celtic lands

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
