

Monnett, 2017-03-16 The Fetterman Fight ranks among the most crushing defeats suffered by the U S Army in the nineteenth century West On December 21 1866 during Red Cloud's War 1866 1868 a well organized force of 1 500 to 2 000 Oglala Lakota Northern Cheyenne and Arapaho warriors annihilated a detachment of seventy nine infantry and cavalry
