Denham, 2018-09-05 Robert D. Denham pursues his quest to uncover the links between Northrop Frye and writers and others who directly influenced his thinking but about whom he did not write an extensive commentary. The first chapter is about Frye's reading of Patanjali, the founder of the philosophy of Hindu yoga, while the second discusses cultural mythographer Giambattista Vico, literary history, and poetic language. The focus of Frye's criticism was the verbal arts, but he also had an abiding interest in both the visual arts and music, hence Frye's admiration of J. S. Bach. The essay on Tolkien examines the tendency in literary history to return from irony to myth, as well as the role that Tolkien played in Frye's fiction writing fantasies. In subsequent chapters, Denham explores Frye's preference for romance and his critique of realism, which
