its recent relative the mask lyric as testing grounds Both genres variously exemplified by poems of Browning Thennyson Eliot and Pound are ex post facto critical constructs that when defined as such make closely reasoned sense not only of particular poems but also of their perplexed interpretive histories Moreover both genres dwell on the historicity textuality and redemptive imperfection of the speaking self This generic obsession ties the poems to their reception and finally to the openended processes of hermeneutic question and answer stressed in Rosmarin's framing theory
