cultural and political influences shaped the transformation of their ideas of what it meant to be Jewish in Germany and how they responded to increasing anti-Semitism. By recognising the way in which the individual's cultural identity was constantly refashioned in the face of external challenges, a fuller understanding of the evolving self-perception of German Jews is reached.

Ein jüdischer Artusritter Achim Jaeger, 2015-04-28 Die Arbeit setzt sich mit dem einzigen erhaltenen Artusroman in jiddisch deutscher Sprache Widuwilt Artushof und seinem Verhältnis zum Wigalois des Wirnt von Gravenberc auseinander. Im Mittelpunkt stehen Fragen eines jiddischen bzw. jiddisch-deutschen Literaturtransfers sowie Aspekte der Rezeptions- und Wirkungsgeschichte des jiddischen Widuwilt und Artushof. Ausgehend von der These der Zufolge Juden fremde Texte nach ihren spezifischen Bedürfnissen veränderten erhebt sich die Frage, warum ein gerade so dezidiert christlicher Roman wie Wigalois von Juden rezipiert wurde. Es lässt sich zeigen, dass die Kürzungen und inhaltliche Modifikationen der jiddischen deutschen Überlieferung darauf abzielen den Protagonisten als einen jiddischen Artusritter erscheinen zu lassen. Im aschkenasischen Raum existierte nämlich bereits im 14./15. Jahrhundert eine jiddische Oberschicht, die Kontakt zur nicht-jiddischen Umwelt pflegte und Literatur als Mittel der gesellschaftlichen Partizipation bzw. der Representation nutzte. Mit der Verbreitung der Drucke weitete sich auch der Rezipientenkreis des Artushof. Die jiddische deutsche Erzähltradition wurde seit dem 17. Jahrhundert von deutscher Seite rezipiert, so von Johann Christof Wagenseil, Johann Ferdinand Roth und Ludwig Uhland. Die parallel zur Wigalois-Rezeption existierende Widuwilt Artushof-Rezeption verdeutlicht, dass es sich bei der Wirkungsgeschichte der Texte um ein Phänomen von langer Dauer handelt.

Suhrkamp und DDR Anke Jaspers, 2022-10-24 Die Studie rekonstruiert erstmals die wechselvolle Beziehungsgeschichte des Suhrkamp Verlags zu Autoren und zur Literatur der DDR. Auf der Basis unveröffentlichter Archivalien liefert sie neue Erkenntnisse über Personenpraktiken sowie Produktionsprozesse und erschließt damit einen Teil der noch weitgehend ungeschriebenen Literaturgeschichte des geteilten Deutschlands. Die Literaturwissenschaftlerin Anke Jaspers erprobt dabei die Möglichkeiten einer praxeologisch ausgerichteten Literaturgeschichte bei der Verlage als zentrale Akteure konzeptionell mit einbezogen werden. Empirisch fundiert führt sie vor, inwiefern sich die Ausgabe als Kategorie zwischen Text und Werk in die Theorie des literarischen Werks integrieren lässt. Am hier entwickelten Genre der Ausgabeninterpretation und unter Berücksichtigung der Rolle von Verlagen in der Literaturproduktion zeigt Jaspers zudem, wie sich intentionalistische Gedankenfiguren der Hermeneutik differenzierter darstellen lassen. Mit dem Blick auf die Mitarbeit von Autoren an der Produktion ihrer Bücher wird zudem eine Materialsthetik literarischer Autorschaft entfaltet.
