What is Health Psychology

Health psychology: the aggregate of the specific educational, scientific and professional contribution of the discipline of psychology to the promotion and maintenance of health, the prevention or treatment of illness, and the identification of etiologic and diagnostic correlates of health, illness, and related dysfunction

1970: psychologists from other non-clinical sub-disciplines began to recognize the many ways psychological principles could be applied to health and health care

Behavioural medicine: one of the first terms used in 1970 to describe the relationship between psychology and health → stressing an integration of biomedical and behavioural approach

- psychology has to offer to the diagnosis and treatment of illness
- people's attempts to maintain health and well-being

WHO, 1946: Health is a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity

The root and branches of health psychology

Neal Miller's 1983 article on behavioral medicine marked the arrival of health psychology

The early stages of health psychology: applying the principles of behaviorism to health

Biomedical perspective on illness: the invention of the microscope and moving to the development of germ theory
