The question then is what went wrong why have these interventions proven to be so ineffective An obvious answer is the drugs were designed to attack the wrong therapeutic target Clearly targeting single ion channels using either isolated ion channels or single myocytes preparations has proven to be less than effective What then is the appropriate target It is well established that cardiac electrical properties can vary substantially between single cells and intact preparations.
