The biosphere is that thin layer at the earth's surface in which living organisms exist and biological cycling takes place. It includes the upper horizons of the soil in which plants root, the atmosphere near the ground insofar as organisms penetrate this space and all the surface waters. More than 99% of the earth's biomass is phytomass to which we shall limit our discussion. Amounts of phytomass are distinctly related to vegetational zones. Because accurate determination of phytomass and primary production is difficult only gross estimates have been available until recently. However in 1970 Bazilevich et al. published in Russian more accurate calculations based on the rapidly accumulating literature for the various thermal zones and bioclimatic regions of the earth. These authors calculated mean phytomass and mean annual primary production for the various regions as dry mass in tons per hectare. On the basis

of measurements of the areas covered by the individual regions excluding rivers lakes glaciers and permanent snow total phytomass and total annual primary production for the various regions were obtained see table The sum of these figures is the phytomass and annual production of the land surface of the earth In addition the table gives corresponding data for the waters of the earth The values involved are potential i e they are based on natural vegetation uninfluenced by man
