The service aristocracy, which had developed in the dark centuries, began to assert itself to the detriment of the peasantry, but, as Howard-Johnston argues, countered reasonably effectively by new legislation. There was a

renaissance in cultural life most marked in the intellectual sphere in the eleventh century Finally the sharp decline in Byzantium's military fortunes from the mid eleventh century is attributed to external factors rather than internal weakness
