Historians have established a norm whereby President Eisenhower's actions in relation to the dawn of the space age are judged solely as a response to the Soviet launch of the Sputnik satellite and are indicative of a passive

negative presidency His low key actions are seen merely as a prelude to the US triumph in space which is largely bookended first by President Kennedy's man to the moon pledge in 1961 and finally by Neil Armstrong's moon landing eight years later This book presents an alternative view of the development of space policy during Eisenhower's administration assessing the hypothesis that his space policy was not a reaction to the heavily propagandized Soviet satellite launches or even the effect they caused in the US political and military elites but the continuation of a strategic journey This study engages with three distinct but converging strands of literature and proposes a revised interpretation of Eisenhower's actions in relation to rockets missiles and satellites namely that Eisenhower was operating on a parallel path to the established norm that started with the Bikini Atoll Castle H bomb tests developed through the CIA's reconnaissance efforts and was distilled in the Aeronautics and Space Act of 1958 which set a policy for US involvement in outer space that matched Eisenhower's desire for a balanced budget and fundamental belief in maintaining peace President Eisenhower was not interested in joining a space race while national security underpinned his thinking his space policy actions were strategic steps that actively sidestepped internecine armed forces rivalry and provided a logical next step for both civilian and military space programs at the completion of the International Geophysical Year In reassessing the United States first space policy the book adds to the revisionism under way in relation to the Eisenhower presidency focusing on the Helping Hands that enabled him to wage peace

When Dwight Eisenhower graduated from West Point in 1915 few would have predicted he was destined for greatness A middling student he was denied his first choice of posting missed overseas service in World War I spent a dozen years as a major and never commanded a unit larger than a battalion Yet the young officer made the most of the opportunities he was given made a lasting impression on superiors including George Marshall and eventually gained a reputation as an excellent staff officer with a knack for administration loyalty and getting along Eisenhower was promoted to colonel in March 1941 and sixteen months later was a lieutenant general in command of the European Theater of Operations His rise through the ranks was first painfully slow then meteoric It is one of the great and most important stories in military history and Michael Lee Lanning tells it vividly with an eye for the dramatic turning points in Eisenhower's rise The West Point class of 1915 was the class the stars fell on Fifty nine graduates became generals during World War II but none of that was clear at the time especially not for the young Dwight Eisenhower who graduated 61st in a class of 164 He failed to make the baseball team but made the football team only to see an injury end his playing career and was known as a card player and prankster Denied his request for service in the Philippines Eisenhower was sent to Texas where he spent a good bit of his time coaching football

December Barton's exhausted soldiers moved to Luxembourg to a more restful portion of the front lines only to face the southern flank of the German Ardennes Offensive. By the time the Ivy Division stopped the enemy outside of Luxembourg, Barton was exhausted and physically unable to continue in command. He returned home to live the rest of his life as a distinguished citizen of Augusta, Georgia.

American policies that created close ties and involvement in the affairs of allied nations also constrained allies such as Chiang Kai-shek in Taiwan and Syngman Rhee in South Korea, who often sought to take direct action against the PRC. The heavy role of American military advisors and experts on the ground in East Asia also profoundly shaped the character of these nations, all of which were emerging from war by putting massive resources into the government administration and military forces of newly formed states. With an assertive China using its growing political and military power throughout East Asia, contemporary U.S. security challenges are similar to the situation faced in that earlier contentious era. Eisenhower's policies from 1953 to 1961 clearly demonstrate an awareness of the possibilities for military, economic, and political growth in East Asia and the challenges of deterring Chinese PRC expansion during the early Cold War.
