Frontier Diplomats Lesley Wischmann, 2004 This dual biography highlights the human dimensions of the Upper Missouri fur trade Focusing on two major figures Alexander Culbertson 1809 1879 trader with the American Fur Company founder of Fort Benton and the first white American to live among the Blackfeet Indians and his wife Natoyist Siksina Holy Snake 1825 1893 daughter of Two Suns the chief of the Blood Kainah tribe Lesley Wischmann shows the great influence this couple had on the region Culbertson and Natoyist Siksina worked together for thirty years to promote cooperative relations between Native inhabitants and newly arrived white adventurers and played key roles in the Fort Laramie Treaty Conference of 1851 and treaty negotiations with the Blackfeet tribes in 1855 As she tells the story of these frontier diplomats Wischmann also challenges conventional wisdom about the character of fur traders the nature of the Blackfeet and the role of Indian women

This Far-Off Wild Land Lesley Wischmann, Andrew Dawson, 2013-06-24 In the mid 1800s Andrew Dawson self exiled from his home in Scotland joined the upper Missouri River fur trade and rose through the ranks of the American Fur Company A headstrong young man he had come to America at the age of twenty four after being dismissed from his second job in two years His poignant sense of isolation is evident throughout his letters home between 1844 and 1861 In *This Far Off Wild Land* Lesley Wischmann and Andrew Erskine Dawson a relative of this colorful figure couple an engaging biography of Dawson with thirty seven of his previously unpublished letters from the American frontier Three years after he landed in St Louis Dawson went up the Missouri in 1847 to what is now North Dakota and Montana taking command of Fort Berthold Fort Clark and eventually Fort Benton the premier fur trade post of the day Fort Berthold and Fort Clark where Dawson worked until 1854 remain two of the least documented American Fur Company posts His letters infuse life and occasional high drama to the stories of these forgotten outposts At Fort Benton his insight in establishing commercial warehouses helped the company keep pace with the changing frontier By the time Dawson returned to Scotland after twenty years in what he labeled a far off wild land he had risen to become the last King of the Upper Missouri Thoughtfully annotated Dawson s letters discovered only recently by his relatives provide a rare glimpse into the lonely life of a fur trader in the 1840s and 1850s Unlike the impersonal business correspondence that makes up most fur trade writings Dawson s letters are wonderfully human suffused with raw emotion Combining careful research with a compelling story the authors flesh out the forces that shaped Dawson s personality and the historical events he recorded *The Red and the White: A Family Saga of the American West* Andrew R. Gavett, 2011-12-06 *Guardians of the Frontier* The Cross Family Chronicle 1836 1903 is a story of three generations of the Cross family following their arrival from England in 1836 In 1849 Isaac heads west from New York to fulfill his dream of seeing the frontier before the inevitable inroads of civilization destroy it Arriving in St Louis he takes a job as a carpenter with the American Fur Company and is sent to Fort Pierre Isaac maintains contact with his twin brother Edward and family through a series of letters sent from the frontier He revisits St Louis in the Company of Alexander Culbertson following the death of his friend and fellow carpenter John O Connor In time he becomes a skilled hunter and

scout Among the Sioux lodges at Riverview 35 miles north of Fort Pierre his friendship earns him the name Little Brother Moving on to Fort Union he develops a strong friendship with His Horse Was Wounded an Assiniboiné Indian Like many of the early frontiersman he marries an Indian Her name was Lodge Pole younger sister of his Assiniboiné friend Together they have a son Lodge Pole who by now is known as Manna is killed at Fort Randall while Isaac and the fort's soldiers are in pursuit of James All Yellow a renegade Yanktonai Sioux Indian and his followers Isaac returns to her village in the company of Bear's Child and Speckled Wing There he leaves his son William First Boy in the care of His Horse Was Wounded and his wife Yellow Bird Isaac travels to Fort Abercrombie located along the Red River of the North Colonel Abercrombie hires him to serve as a scout and hunter Here he is killed by his nemesis James All Yellow After Isaac's death in 1859 his nephew Abe Cross leaves New York and makes his way to Fort Abercrombie to gather his uncle's belongings and find his son He is successful in locating William First Boy but while at Fort Union in 1862 he learns of the outbreak of the Civil War He joins several other men in returning to St Louis to join in the fight Together the men join the 10th Missouri Volunteer Cavalry In 1864 the men of the 10th under the command of Major Frederick Benteen participate in the Battle of Mine Creek Abe receives a letter 1865 notifying him of the death of his parents Edward and Charlotte Following the war he returns to their family farm near Hawkins Landing New York to settle his affairs Departing New York he returns to the frontier in search of Isaac's son While at Fort Berthold Abe learns that Sweet Bears a Hidatsa Indian and wife of his deceased friend Judd Strong is alive and well following her escape from her Sioux captives She becomes his wife and together they search out William First Boy When His Horse Was Wounded is killed hunting buffalo Abe Sweet Bears Yellow Bird and William First Boy leave the Assiniboiné village never to return They make their way east toward the Mouse River resettling along the Wintering River Dakota Territory Smallpox contracted from three broke down and out white prospectors takes the lives of Sweet Bears and Yellow Bird in 1866 Abe and William establish the Cross Ranch along the Wintering River where they develop a new breed of horses and raise a few Texas Longhorns William marries Rebecca Stevenson in 1880 Their son William is two and one half when his father suffering from bouts of extreme depression commits suicide In time Rebecca remarries Kincaid a trusted friend and long time employee partner of Abe Cross Death comes to Abe in 1903 followed by Rebecca in 1908 Kincaid lived for few more years dying in an automotive accident 1911 The Cross Ranch is sold breaking it up into several farms All that remains to remind new generations of the days of yesteryear along the Wintering River is the small weathered cemetery of the Cross family William Cross married Hilma Youngquist After living in several small towns in McLean and Ward Counties the

Painted Journeys Peter H. Hassrick, Mindy N.
