account of agency in naturalist terms and how it is that agency requires such a self division while the second part explores how Hegel thinks a historical narration is essential for understanding what this kind of self division has come to require of itself In making his case Hegel argues that both the antinomies of philosophical thought and the essential fragmentation of modern life are all not to be understood as overcome in a higher order unity in the State On the contrary Hegel demonstrates that modern institutions do not resolve such tensions any more than a comprehensive philosophical account can resolve them theoretically The job of modern practices and institutions and at a reflective level the task of modern philosophy is to help us understand and live with precisely the unresolvability of these oppositions Therefore Pinkard explains Hegel is not the totality theorist he has been taken to be nor is he an identity thinker la Adorno He is an anti totality thinker
