great fires Along with Wallace the valley encompasses many other small mining towns such as Mullan Silverton Osburn Kellogg Smelterville Pinehurst and Kingston with diverse histories that are both humorous and heartbreaking It also surrounds the Cataldo Mission Idaho s oldest standing building built by the Jesuits and the Coeur d Alene tribe in 1848
