Hell Frozen Over Marilyn Estes Quigley, 2004-08-06 Europe's winter of the century 1944-1945 occurred during the conflict of the century World War II. On December 16, bitter weather and brutal warfare tragically met in Southeastern Belgium's rolling hills of the Ardennes where the 106th Division had arrived only five days earlier. The well-trained but inexperienced soldiers were soon overwhelmed by Hitler's tanks and troops surging into Belgium. *Hell Frozen Over* describes the personal experiences of sixteen men, most of them in the 81st Engineers who were caught in Hitler's final grasp to strangle the continent. More than half of these men were among the 7,001 in the Division who were taken as prisoners of war. Scattered in camps throughout Germany, they willed themselves to survive as deprivation and even slave labor threatened their lives and sanity. Their comrades in arms who escaped capture and remained to fight in foxholes and tanks had other hells to endure as did the civilians of every town in the area. That winter war permanently stamped its cold, dark memories on the souls of America's young men who found themselves in the Battle of the Bulge. Their stories, many of them told after many decades of silence, will inspire Americans to realize that the human spirit can survive even the worst circumstances. The torturous experiences of that dedicated generation will remind both present and future generations that freedom from tyranny has come at a horrible price.

Snow and Steel Peter Caddick-Adams, 2014-10-31 Between December 16, 1944 and January 15, 1945, American forces found themselves entrenched in the heavily forested Ardennes region of Belgium, France, and Luxembourg, defending against an advancing German army amid freezing temperatures, deep snow, and dense fog. Operation *Herbstnebel* (Autumn Mist) was a massive German counter-offensive that stunned the Allies in its scope and intensity. In the end, the 40-day long Battle of the Bulge, as it has come to be called, was the bloodiest battle fought by U.S. forces in World War II and indeed the largest land battle in American history. Before effectively halting the German advance, some 89,000 of the 610,000 American servicemen committed to the campaign had become casualties, including 19,000 killed. The engagement saw the taking of thousands of Americans as prisoners of war, some of whom were massacred by the SS, but it also witnessed the storied stand by U.S. forces at Bastogne as German forces besieged the region and culminated in a decisive, if costly, American victory. Ordered and directed by Hitler himself against the advice of his generals, the Ardennes offensive was the last major German offensive on the Western Front. In the wake of the defeat, many experienced German units were left severely depleted of men and equipment. Its last reserve squandered, these irreplaceable losses would hasten the end of the war. In *Snow and Steel*, Peter Caddick-Adams draws on interviews with over 100 participants of the campaign, as well as archival material from both German and US sources, to offer an engagingly written and thorough reassessment of the historic battle. Exploring the failings of intelligence that were rife on both sides, the effects of weather, and the influence of terrain on the battle's outcome, Caddick-Adams deftly details the differences in weaponry and doctrine between the US and German forces while offering new insights into the origins of the battle, the characters of those involved, on both the American

and German sides from the general staff to the foot soldiers the preparedness of troops and the decisions and tactics that precipitated the German retreat and the American victory Re examining the SS and German infantry units in the Bulge he shows that far from being deadly military units they were nearly all under strength short on equipment and poorly trained kept in the dark about the attack until the last minute they fought in total ignorance of their opponents or the terrain Ultimately Caddick Adams concludes that the German assault was doomed to failure from the start Aided by an intimate knowledge of the battlefield itself and over twenty years of personal battlefield experience Caddick Adams has produced the most compelling and complete account of the Bulge yet written

August 3 1944 Lieutenant Adkins and his fellow soldiers took part in light hedgerow fighting that served to shake the division down and familiarize the troops and their officers with combat The first real test came within weeks when the 2nd Battalion 317th Infantry attacked high ground near Argentan during the drive to seal German forces in the Falaise Pocket While scouting for mortar positions in the woods Adkins met a group of Germans and shot one of them dead with his carbine This baptism in blood settled the question faced by every novice combatant He was cool under fire capable of killing when facing the enemy He later wrote It was a sickening sight but having been caught up in the heat of battle I didn't have a reaction other than feeling I had saved my own life Thereafter the 2nd Battalion 317th Infantry took part in bloody battles across France sometimes coping with inept leadership and grievous losses even as it took hills and towns away from the Germans In the fighting graphically portrayed here Adkins acted with skill and courage placing himself at the forefront of the action whenever he could His extremely aggressive delivery of critical supplies to a cut off unit in an embattled French town earned him a Bronze Star the first in his battalion This is a story of a young soldier at war a junior officer's coming of age amid pulse pounding combat Before his death Andy Adkins was able to face his memory of war as bravely as he faced war itself He put it on paper honest and unflinching In 1944-45 he did his duty to his men and country and here he serves new generations of military and civilian readers
