1 The breakdown of communism in 1991 had been anticipated by few contemporary scholars although the majority were aware of the symptoms of a deep crisis. In this essay I will argue that in order to better understand the collapse of communism in the Soviet Union a central role must be given to the economy and its effects on other areas.
