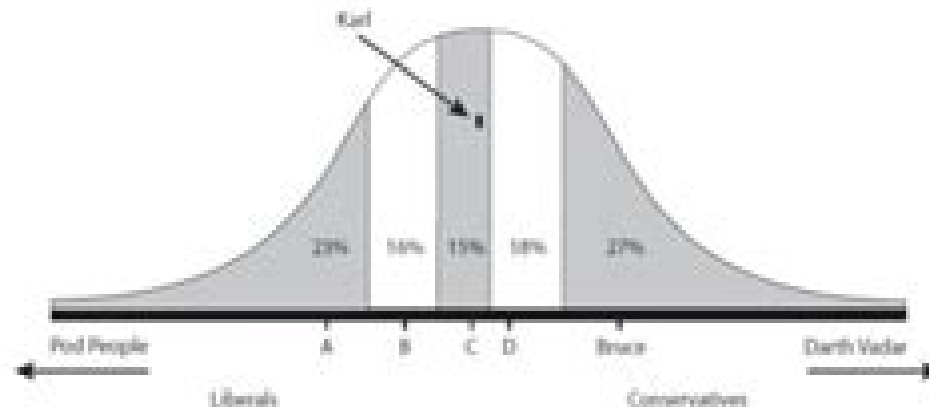


# An Economic Theory of Democracy
