Demographic reconstructions revealed the great auk had a large and stable effective population size with no evidence of decline associated with periods of climatic change. Population viability analysis indicated that harvesting of 5–7% of the total population would be required to cause extinction in a period of fewer than 350 years, levels commensurate with documented observations. Findings are consistent with the current consensus that human hunting was the primary cause of the great auk's extinction. Additional analysis of nuclear DNA yielded no data due to low coverage of the 495 targeted markers. Related analyses on mitochondrial genomes of five candidate specimens and the organs from the last documented pair of great auks allowed for a 170-year-old
