Burton, 2018-10-18 The Terror of 1793-94 the Paris Commune of 1871 the Dreyfus Affair explosions of violence punctuated French history from the start of the Revolution until the Liberation at the close of World War II The distinguished scholar Richard D E Burton here offers a stunningly
